But it also speaks deeply of relationship and of community. Eugene Peterson (*The Message*) translates the last part of the verse like this: "my life is on display in them." How we live and love in this world is the presentation of Christ to those who don't know him yet. How we share and give does not just reflect on us, but it reflects on Jesus. How we treat one another, how we honor one another, how we celebrate one another and the commitments we have made are parts of our faith. And Christ is glorified by the way we live in community.
